KTA barely skipped a beat this past year! With health safety measures put in place, we continued our tuition-free acting, dance, and technical production courses for Bridgeport youth. Here are some recent highlights:

In the summer, we added editing to our video production course thanks to receiving funds to purchase a laptop and our own video editing software. Now students are writing, filming, starring in *AND* editing their own videos! An **Arts** Expression course was also added in the fall of 2020.

The students have expressed how much they love to be able to continue the courses in-person so they can still come in and socialize with others.

We added 2 production interns this year, and plan to add 2 more as they turn 16.

appearances. Although most events were
cancelled last summer, KDC did get to
perform at the American Legion Post 140
Cookout, where our student Jaysa received
the John Lewis Youth Award for
Environmental Justice and Civic
Engagement. This summer, KDC already



received an invitation to perform in the Juneteenth Parade on June 19th.

Our **spring semester concert** will be livestreamed on March 25th, and shortly after we'll be recruiting for the summer semester of our 9th year.
